Ride to *Monsoon Valley*

A direct 38 km run west from Hua Hin into the hills via Soi 112 — smooth roads, scenic countryside, cold wine at the finish.



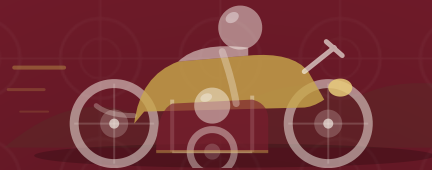

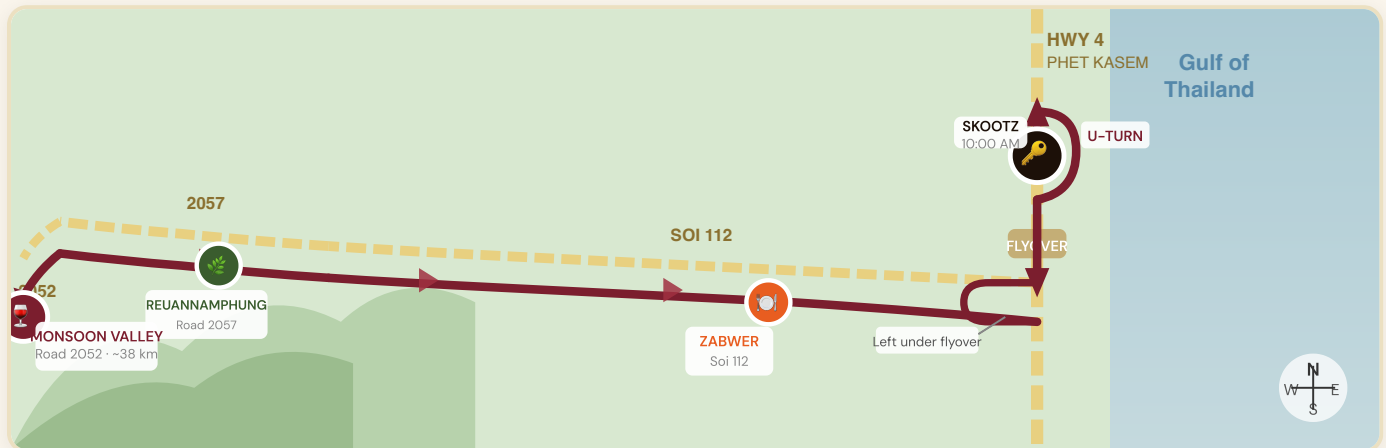

STEP-BY-STEP DIRECTIONS

STEP 1 – LEAVE SKOOTZ HEADING NORTH

~0.5 km · 2 min

- ▶ Exit Skootz, turn **right (north)** onto Phet Kasem Rd **HWY 4**
- ▶ Ride a short distance north, then make a **U-turn** to head south

STEP 2 – OVER THE FLYOVER, THEN LEFT UNDERNEATH

~1 km · 3 min

- ▶ Head **south** on Phet Kasem Rd and **go over the flyover**
- ▶ Immediately after the flyover, turn **left** and loop back **under the flyover**
- ▶ Turn **right onto Soi 112** — heading west into the countryside

STEP 3 – SOI 112 WEST → ROAD 2057

~15 km · ~20 min · 🍽️ Zabwer Restaurant on this stretch

- ▶ Follow **Soi 112** west through local villages and open countryside
- ▶ Road becomes **2057** — continue heading west, same direction
- ▶ 🌿 **Reuannamphung** garden café on this stretch — great refreshment stop

STEP 4 – ROAD 2052 TO MONSOON VALLEY

~22 km total · ~25 more min · same direction as Huay Mongkol temple

- ▶ Road becomes **2052** — continue west into the hills
- ▶ Pass through rubber plantations and rolling hillside — beautiful riding
- ▶ Watch for **Monsoon Valley Vineyard** sign — turn in and follow the access road uphill 🍷



Start early

Depart by 10 AM — cooler air and the vineyard quieter before the lunch crowd.



All bikes fully fuelled

Every Skootz hire goes out with a full tank — no need to stop for fuel.



Scenic riding

Soi 112 through to 2052 is light on traffic — a genuinely great road for any bike.



Return by 5 PM

Golden-hour light through the hill roads on the way back — don't miss it.



START · 10:00 AM

Open 10 AM – 6 PM · All bikes fully fuelled

Choose your ride — scooter, motorbike, trike or sidecar. Bring passport copy + deposit. Head **north** out of Skootz to begin the route.
